Giuseppe Arcimboldo was an artist from Milan, Italy.

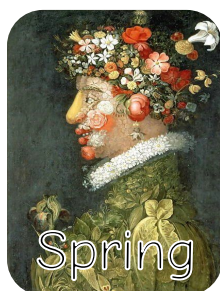
He was born in 1526 and died in 1593.

He is most famous for creating portraits using natural objects.

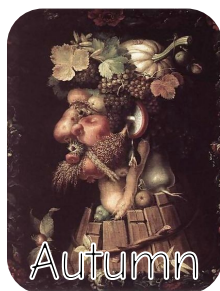

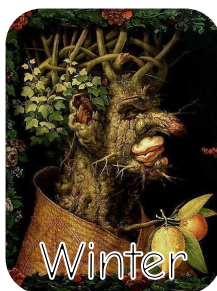

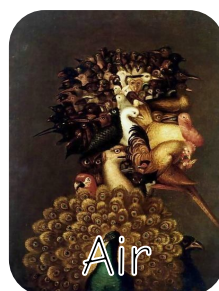

Key Vocabulary
