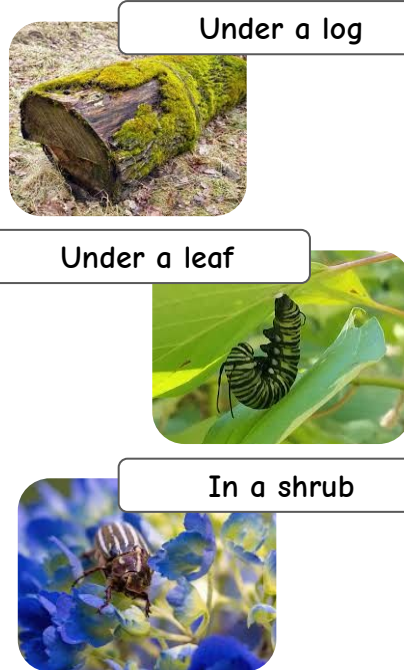

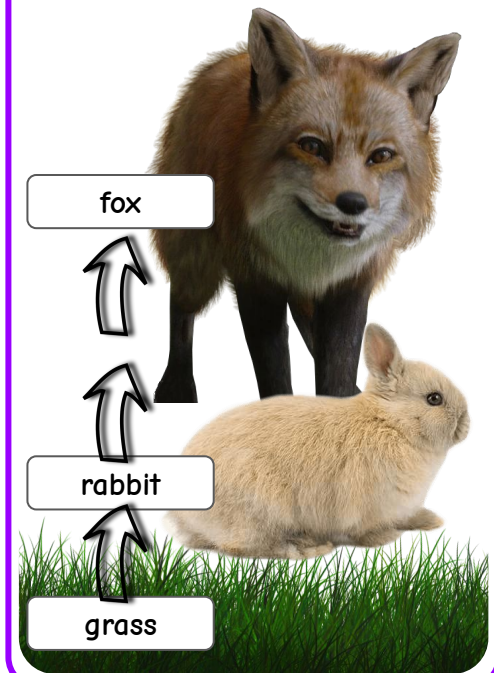

Key Vocabulary

consumer- a consumer eats producers and other consumers in a food chain

environment- the area in which something exists or lives

habitat- a place that an animal or plant lives. It provides the animal or plant with food, water and shelter

inhabitant- a person or animal that lives in a place

microhabitat- a very small, specific habitat for animals and plants

organism- a living thing

producer- an organism that makes its own food, such as a plant
