Dear Parents/Carers,

Year 4 Barnstondale Residential Visit (Monday 13- Wednesday 15th April 2026)

As you are aware, many pupils in our current Year 4 cohort are due to visit Barnstondale on the first Monday back after the Spring break. May I take this opportunity to remind all our parents/carers of essential information regarding this residential:

Kit List

*towel

*Wash bag and toiletries

* at least x3 pairs of tracksuit bottoms/leggings (please note that children must wear long trousers/leggings for activities and these will get dirty/scuffed)

*x4 pairs of underwear

*x4 pairs of socks

*slippers

*Nightwear

*x2 hoodie/long sleeve top

X3 t shirts

X2 pairs of trainers (essential- please note that at least one pair will get wet/dirty)

X1 empty bin bag (to store soiled clothing)

X1 lightweight waterproof jacket (essential- please ensure that your child is wearing this jacket to travel to Barnstondale and that it has a hood and is waterproof)

*Cap/sunglasses/sunscreen



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* a teddy bear (if desired)

*An empty refillable water bottle

*Please note that money or sweets are not permitted. Additionally, devices, electric/battery operated items of any kind or cameras/phones are not permitted.

Departure and Pick- up times

Departure-Monday 13th April 2026

Arrive at school at the usual time in comfortable clothing (long trousers/leggings are essential) and your waterproof jacket. Please line up by the ramp and we will escort you into school and place your case in the Ley Hall. All cases must be clearly labelled with your child's name and must have wheels. Children attending the residential must be able to transport their case and cases **must be cabin sized cases** otherwise they will not all fit on the coach.

The children will be required to take their cases to and from the coaches.

Pick-up-Wednesday 15th April

We are due to arrive back at school at approximately 2pm. Parents/carers should collect their child at the earlier time of 2pm. We kindly ask that parents/carers wait for the children to depart the coach and to collect their luggage before approaching the staff. We will then line the children up and dismiss them accordingly. Siblings will be allowed to leave, however please let Mrs Hyam know.

Medication

If your child requires any medication, please give this to Mrs Minogue and Mr Quilty as you drop your child off on Monday 13th April. Please only give medication for the duration of the residential and medication that is essential. If your child requires antihistamine, please provide this in tablet form and ensure that any medication contains clear instructions and is stored in a clearly labelled bag with your child's name, class and dosage.



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If your child has any significant medical needs or allergies or indeed if you have any concerns such as bed wetting, please call school to arrange a phone call with Mrs Minogue before we break up for the Spring Break on Friday. If your child requires any travel sickness medication, please ensure that you administer this before you drop your child off at school.

Packed Lunches

Any child who usually has a school lunch will be given a packed lunch on the day of departure. However, if your child normally brings in a packed lunch from home each day, they must also bring in a packed lunch on the 13th April (no nuts, fizzy drinks, chocolate or sweets). May we kindly ask that you do not use Tupperware boxes or lunch bags that cannot be disposed of on this day.

Please note, the children must not bring any money with them on this trip.

Furthermore, please note that any children who are not attending this residential must come to school as usual each day.
