Year4 Barnstondale Residential Visit (13-15th April 2026 - £260)

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are delighted to have secured a two-night residential at Barnstondale Activity Centre, Wirral for our Year 4 pupils (Monday 13th- Wednesday 15th April 2026). Last year's residential was a huge success and really helped to develop the team work, confidence and problem-solving skills of our Young Edwardians.

The cost of this residential is £260. However, we need a minimum of 60 children to sign up to keep the cost at this price. All payments can be made using Arbor. Please ensure that you sign up for this residential as soon as possible and pay the £60 deposit by Wednesday 9th October 2025 to secure your child's place.

If you do not wish for your child to take place in this residential please note that they will need to attend school, as usual, each day.

Please also note that this price is subject to change depending upon pupil numbers attending and that once you sign up you are liable to pay for the full cost of the residential.

All payment must be received by Friday 27th March 2026.

May we remind parents/carers that once you sign up and pay your deposit, you are liable to pay for the full cost of the residential. If your child's behavior or attendance is not to an acceptable standard attendance on the residential will not be permitted and you will still be liable to pay the full cost of the residential (£260.00).

Pocket Money

Children will not need any pocket money for the residential. All children attending the trip will be able to visit our tuck shop each evening and this cost has been included within the price.

Medication

If your child requires any medication, please ensure that this is handed in to Mrs Minogue and Miss Peaston on the day of departure. All medication must be stored in a clearly labelled bag/envelope and instructions as to how to administer it must be included and explained before we leave. If your child usually suffers from travel sickness, please give them their medication before dropping them off at school at the usual time of 08.45 (we are due to depart from school at 10am sharp) and let us know. Additionally, please remember to give us travel sickness medication for the inbound journey.

Packed Lunch

Any child who usually has a school lunch will be given a packed lunch on the day of departure. However, if your child normally brings in a packed lunch from home each day, they must also bring in a packed lunch on the 13th April (no nuts, fizzy drinks or chocolate permitted- please adhere to our school packed lunch policy which can be found on our website).

Kit List

Please ensure that you pack the items listed on the kit list and that all items are clearly labelled with your child's name. It is also recommended that you pack alongside your child so they have a clear understanding of which items are theirs and where they are located in their case. Please ensure that your child can manage their case and that the case is as small as possible as we only have the one coach transporting us to the centre. Please also ensure that you pack a few carrier bags for children to store wet/dirty clothes and that your child packs a refillable water bottle and sun cream. Electronic devices/phones are not permitted.

All children must pack a lightweight waterproof jacket (with hood) and a cap/sunglasses, as most of the activities will take place outside whatever the weather. All children must also pack at least two pairs of trainers. Please note that most of the activities are adventure based and that the children will get dirty. Barnstondale also ask the children to wear long sleeves and trousers when completing adventure-based activities.

Departure and Pick up Times:

Monday 13th April 2026- Arrive at school at the usual time. Please enter school via the ramp and then place your case in the Ley Hall (all cases should be labelled with your child's name). Parents/carers may wave their children off at 09.15am if they do so wish.

Wednesday 15th April 2026- Arrive at school at approximately 2pm. Parents/carers should collect their child at the earlier time of 2pm. We kindly ask that parents/carers wait for all children to depart the coaches and collect their luggage before approaching children. Our staff will line the children up before dismissing the children.
