Year 4 Barnstondale Residential Visit (9-11th June £340)

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are delighted to have secured a two-night residential at Barnstondale Activity Centre, Wirral for our Year 4 pupils (Monday 9th- Wednesday 11th June 2025). Last year's residential was a huge success and really helped to develop the team work, confidence and problem-solving skills of our Young Edwardians. We are also taking our Year 5 pupils the following week.

The cost of this residential is £340 and can be paid using Arbor. Please ensure that you sign up for this residential as soon as possible and pay a small deposit to secure your child's place. Please also note that this price is subject to change depending upon pupil numbers attending and that once you sign up you are liable to pay for the full cost of the residential. All payment must be received by Friday 30th May 2025.

Packed Lunch

Any child who usually has a school lunch will be given a packed lunch on the day of departure. However, if your child normally brings in a packed lunch from home each day, they must also bring in a packed lunch on the 9th June (no nuts, fizzy drinks or chocolate permitted- please adhere to our school packed lunch policy which can be found on our website).

Kit List

Please ensure that you pack the items listed on the kit list and that all items are clearly labelled with your child's name. It is also recommended that you pack alongside your child so they have a clear understanding of which items are theirs and where they are located in their case. Please ensure that your child can manage their case and that the case is as small as possible as we only have the one coach transporting us to the centre. Please also ensure that you pack a few carrier bags for children to store wet/dirty clothes and that your child packs a refillable water bottle and sun cream. Electronic devices/phones are not permitted. All children must pack a lightweight waterproof jacket (with hood) and a cap/sunglasses, as most of the activities will take place outside whatever the weather.
