As part of Black History Month, Year 6 will be visiting the International Slavery Museum at the Albert Dock on **Wednesday 23rd October, 2024**. As well as exploring the various exhibits, we are extremely fortunate to have booked a workshop led by museum staff, which I know will really help to bring the children's learning to life. This is the fourth consecutive year that we have been on this trip and it is always a huge success.

Please ensure that your child arrives at school at **the usual** time on the day. We will arrive back in plenty of time for the children to be dismissed at the normal time of **3:20pm**. Upon return, for the safety of all children, they will be first brought into school and then dismissed in the usual manner. Children will not be dismissed directly from the coach.
