Homework Schedule

Dear Parents and Carers,

Please find details of our homework schedule for each group for this academic year. Please note that homework tasks will commence from Monday 23rd September 2024.

Reception:

Children in Reception will get the opportunity to select a school library book each week. These will be sent home every Tuesday and must be returned by the following Monday. After half term, Reception children will be placed into 'Read, Write, Inc' Phonic Groups. A range of phonic activities will be sent home for children to complete and more details regarding these tasks will follow shortly. Occasionally, children may also be given a QR code for parents/carers to scan at home which will lead to a phonics video link for your child to watch to consolidate learning undertaken in class.

Year 1:

Children in Year 1 will have two Reading/Phonics 'Read, Write, Inc' books sent home each week. These books will be sent home each Friday and must be returned to school the following Thursday. It is suggested that pupils read each of these books at least three times at home during this period in order to progress with their recognition and fluency. Occasionally, children may also be given a QR code for parents/carers to scan at home which will lead to a phonics video link for your child to watch to consolidate learning undertaken in class.

Additionally, your child may have sounds that they need to practise. Please check your child's book bag daily.

Year 2:

Children in Year 2 will take home a Spelling, English and Maths task in a plastic wallet each week. These tasks will be assigned every Friday and should be completed and returned to their class teacher by the following Thursday. Pupils will also be given a reading book and Reading Record to take home each Friday. Please ensure that you listen to your child read and sign this book making a comment if necessary. Reading books and Reading Records should be brought into school each day in your child's bag to enable our teachers/reading volunteers to listen to your child read.

Occasionally, children may also be given a QR code for parents/carers to scan at home which will lead to a phonics video link for your child to watch to consolidate learning undertaken in class.

Pupils will also have access to TTRockstars and we suggest that they access this platform at least twice per week.

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*Some children in Year 2 may still follow the 'Read, Write, Inc' Scheme during the Autumn Term and therefore will also follow the schedule for Year 1.

Year 3-6:

Children in Year 3-6 will have tasks assigned to them using our new Artificial Intelligence Learning Platform 'Century'. These tasks will be assigned every Friday and should be completed by the following Thursday. Pupils will also be given a reading book and Reading Record to take home each Friday. Please ensure that you listen to your child read and sign this book making a comment if necessary. Reading books and Reading Records should be brought into school each day in your child's bag to enable our teachers/reading volunteers to listen to your child read.

Pupils will also have access to TTRockstars and we suggest that they access this platform at least once per week.

In addition, a spelling and times tables task will also be sent home for children to complete/practise at home in preparation for their weekly test.
