Therefore, in order to ensure that **ALL** children are safe around the school we must insist on the following being strictly adhered to:

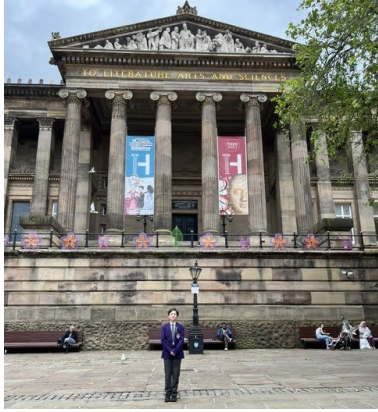
