This week the first group of our skiers participated in a 2 hour lesson at Chill Factore in Manchester.

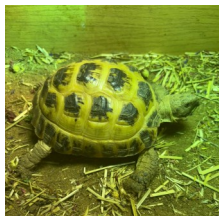
They also enjoyed getting their in our new school mini-bus!
