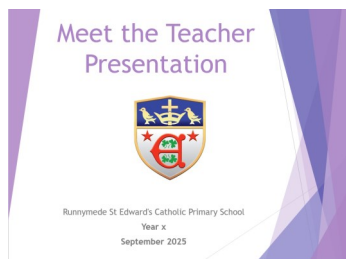

Thank you for your lovely feedback on our new 'Meet the Teacher' events. I am very pleased you have found them informative and helpful.



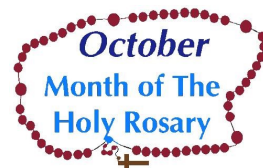

Maths in Action!

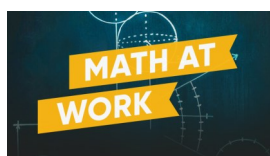
In celebration of *Maths Party Day on 17th October*, we'd love to see how our children use maths in everyday life.

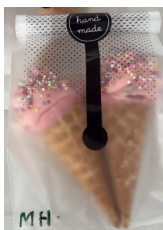
Thank you to everyone who contributed to our MacMillan Coffee Morning.
