Your generosity will help support families in need in our local area.



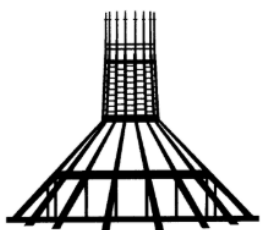
Chorister Residential
